












Gratitude for Ignite Youth Ministry

CAMP HOPE: MEMORIES OF GRACE

A PERSONAL REFLECTION

When I was asked to write about Camp Hope, my first response was to smile. Camp has always provided me with some of my life's best memories. I know that growth in my spiritual life and some of my closest relationships have come from serving at Camp Hope. Camp has also provided great memories and lasting friendships for my family.

When my husband Jim, and I first began attending events with the People of Hope Community, we began to hear about Camp Hope and the wonderful things that happened there. Because our children were still young, we did not experience Camp life right away. We were aware of Camp and heard great witnesses at Camp prayer meetings, but my first experience came when my oldest children were starting camp as 2nd and 3rd graders. I was asked to serve in the kitchen that first year, with the amazing Doreen Gazzo leading the way. Jim stayed home and heroically held down the fort caring for the rest of the family. I had no idea what to expect, but what I experienced was fellowship with the staff, a revival of my spiritual life and the beginning of friendships that bless me to this day. In addition, I was able to watch my children mature in their relationship with the Lord, navigate challenges that helped them grow in virtue and make lifelong friendships.

Working in the kitchen was very hard work and I was very challenged by the hours and effort needed. I found however, that the day flew by while we cut lettuce, rolled handmade cinnamon rolls, all the while laughing and chatting the time away. The fellowship time was amazing. In the meantime, I was able to experience the spiritual talks, prayer times, Eucharistic Adoration and the Masses with everyone at Camp. The spiritual life at Camp reinvigorated my own spirit and helped me to grow spiritually. It became clear to me that Camp would become a very important part of our family life.

After 2 years in the kitchen, I was asked to serve with Pat Weyand and Laura Greey. My role was to run the girl's activities and support Pat and Laura in any way I could. Organizing the girl's activities gave me the opportunity to work with great young people who constantly amazed me (and sometimes challenged me) with their creativity, energy and joy. Every day I experienced the Lord working in all their lives as well as my own. Year after year the Lord provided me with a new perspective and the grace to carry on while navigating the challenges of raising a young family.

My favorite memory from Camp was the laughter. A wonderful time of the day was in the afternoon when there was a bit of a break from work. We would stand on the porch of the dining hall watching the campers having fun together. We would also have a fire pit at the end of the night at the top of the hill to keep an eye on the campers as they ended their day. My children still mention how they loved hearing the laughter from the top of the hill.

Although I stopped volunteering at Camp a number of years ago, fond memories still come to mind especially at this time of the year. I encourage anyone who is able to take time out and volunteer at Camp Hope. The experience is life changing. I am praying for this year's Camp and I thank everyone who has helped organize and serve Camp Hope 2025. You are a blessing!

Spending time away with the Lord on retreat is very important to our spiritual health. It's like getting a spiritual tune-up.


