
Celebrating 50 years of priesthood!

On December 20, 2018 Fr. Brendan Murray celebrated 50 years of priesthood. Fr. Brendan was ordained in 1968 at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. He has served in many parishes, as a hospital chaplain at St. Joseph's hospital in Paterson, and for 12 years he was assigned full time to the People of Hope. For the past 11 years he has been pastor of Sacred Heart and Holy Rosary Parish(s) in Dover NJ. This past Sunday, April 28, the parish celebrated his anniversary and his upcoming retirement. 400 people attended the Mass and reception. Many stories were told of Fr. Brendan's ministry, and testimonies noting miracles that have happened through Fr. Brendan's intercession. It was a wonderful afternoon of fun and faith building. Fr. Brendan will officially retire on June 13, 2019. He will be assigned as temporary administrator of Our Lady of Peace in Branchville, NJ until Aug. 22.
